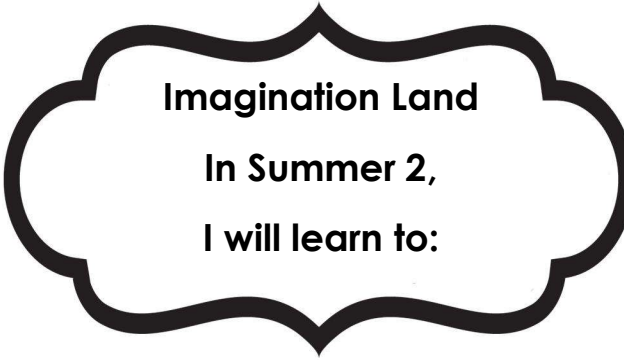

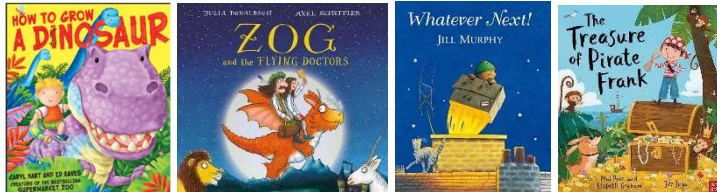

<p>We follow the Twinkl phonics scheme which follows the letters and sounds progressional model.</p> <p>Comprehension Play imaginatively based on stories read in class.</p> <p>Word reading Recap previously taught sounds, building confidence in reading sentences and re-reading the sentence for fluency.</p> <p>Writing Recap previously taught sounds and build confidence in writing sentences using features such as capital letters, full stops and finger spaces.</p>	<p>We follow the Mastering Number and White Rose progressional models for maths.</p> <p>Number Continue to develop maths fluency and composition of number.</p> <p>Numerical Patterns Continue to explore patterns in numbers including sharing and halving.</p>	<p>Past and Present Explore the past through dinosaurs, castles and space historical figures.
