



PTFA Meeting 22.09.2023. Held in school – 3.30pm

Minutes from the last meeting: Minutes from the previous meeting had been circulated prior and approved. This is the first meeting of the new academic year.

Matters Arising:

<u>Trip Contribution</u> – The PTFA in recent years have made a £5 per child contribution towards school trips. This was increased last year to £15 per child to help with the cost of living crisis. The group discussed whether this was a good way to spend our funds. Over £1600 last year was used for this. The overwhelming feeling from the group was that we should no longer contribute. Trips will be canvassed by teachers in advance of booking them to determine if they can go ahead or not financially.

It was agreed that the PTFA would rather use that money to fund activities outright such as a panto. KH also raised the concern for the current Y4 class being only 14 pupils. Due to extortionate transport costs and the extremely small class, trips are coming out very expensive. SG agreed that the PTFA will look at these to hopefully help out and bring the cost down so they do not miss out.
